## Review of Meeting Minutes

Kent Martin welcomed the committee turned it over to Tyler who asked the committee members to review the minutes from the May 9<sup>th</sup> committee meeting. Minutes were approved.

## Additional Materials Review

From the May 9<sup>th</sup> meeting, committee members requested some additional charts and maps for their work this evening. The following items were provided:

- Overview table of the existing student demographics (e.g. free/reduced lunch %, racial diversity %, special education %) in comparison to the same demographics in the springboard proposal
- Chart of MS student area attendance totals (where students live) and eventual enrollment capacities at each of the eventual six district middle schools. This data is shown for current student residents and is shown as projected student residents in 2021 and in 2026 in the district middle schools
- District map of home building planning and development data culled from the City of Liberty Lake, the City of Spokane Valley and Spokane County planning departments
- A map of developable lands from the planning entities outlined above

## Boundary Review in Workgroups and Ensuing Group Discussion

Three workgroups continued their discussions from May 9<sup>th</sup> on possible changes to the springboard proposal boundaries utilizing the core guiding principles from the Board of Directors as a resource. Tyler, Alex and Jenny utilized the computer program to model three proposals that came forward as a result of this work so that all committee members could see the enrollment number changes that resulted from these boundary adjustments.

Each workgroup presented their springboard boundary adjustment proposals to the entire group, each detailing the impetus for each change, and how these changes met the guiding principles. The non-presenting group

members asked clarifying questions. There were many similarities between the three proposals. After continued discussion a proposal was agreed upon to take to the community forum the next week for community input.

### **Open House Discussion**

The FLO team presented some tips to the committee members for working well with patrons at a community forum event. The first of two Community Forums for this boundary review and adjustment process is scheduled for next Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> in the Evergreen Middle School commons from 6:00 – 8:00 PM. Maps with this agreed upon boundary proposal will be available, and both handwritten and electronic feedback from patrons will be elicited during this forum.
