NOTICE OF CITIZEN'S OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Governing Board of the Wasco Union High School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for Measure C School Facilities Bond program.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure C bond proceeds;
- Review the expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure C bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure C;
- Present to the Governing Board of the District, in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure C bond proceeds.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Governing Board from applications submitted to the district.

Time Commitment and Term

Initial appointments will be staggered, such that some of the initial appointees will be appointed to serve one full two-year term. The other initial appointments will serve a one-year term, but will be eligible for reappointment by the Board for a second two-year term.

Membership Number

- One (1) member shall be the parent or guardian of a student enrolled in the District
- One (1) member shall be both a parent or guardian of a student enrolled in the District and active in Parent-Teacher Organization, such as School Site Council or Booster Club
- One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District
- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers association
- Two (2) members of the community at-large

(Employees, vendors, contractors, and consultants of the Wasco Union High School District are prohibited by law from being members of the Citizens' Oversight Committee. Employment which could result in becoming a contractor or subcontractor to the district would also be a potential conflict.)
