- Magali explained electing officers and the role each officer plays. Pamela explained that this year it needs to be a mailed ballot and the committee decided to do the ballot by mail since that is what District is requesting according to Pam
- Magali asks about what parents want the next meetings to cover. Benito Garcia says he would like community college representatives to present. Pamela suggests UCLA as well as she has a contact there. Isabel Martinez says she would like to know more about reclassifying and Neonilla would like to as well. Isabel Martinez states she feels students like her son (a long time EL student) need more support. She would like more information as to the supports in place and then the committee says they feel funds would be good for non-newcomer tutoring. Magali states she will communicate this with administration to get non-newcomer tutoring in place.
