**Review** Data and Progress

**Analyze** Data and Progress

**Recommend** Action and Services

**Develop and approve** LCAP and other required addendums prior to July 1

# PERFORMANCE

## STATUS and CHANGE

- Current year data and how that data varies from the prior year data are represented on a 5x5 grid (some exceptions)
- The grid layout will vary for each measure.
- The performance level, or color, is determined by the point at which the two data levels intersect.

Local indicators are self-reported as Standard Met, Standard Not Met, or Standard Not Met for 2 years

Tool reflects areas of improvement to address in LCAP and district programs and services.

### LEA Driven

The Dashboard is a comparative look of the district and our schools, as aligned to the state priorities. More than a single test result.

### Equity

The Dashboard allows a comparative look at various student group performance across multiple measurements.

### System of Support

Connects districts and schools struggling with student group performance to a network of experts, resources and tailored assistance.

## Key Changes in 2018

- **Suspension Rate:** Apply 3x5 grid at student group level
- **Chronic Absenteeism:** Reported for first time
- **English Learner Progress:** Transition year, report assessment results only
- **Graduation Rate:** 4-year & DASS graduation rate; 3x5 at student group level
- **College/Career Indicator:** New measures and first time color
- **Academic English and Math:** Adding Grade 11 and participation rate
- **N-size:** 30 or more students current and prior; 15 foster/homeless
