Public Random Drawing Procedures 2019-20 Enrollment

Synergy Quantum Academy will accept applications for enrollment in the 2019-20 school year between November 1, 2018 and December 14, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. A public random drawing (lottery) will be held on January 26, 2019 to determine admission for any grades in which the number of applications received is greater than the number of spaces available.

Currently enrolled students are exempt from the lottery.

Admission preferences* in the case of a public random drawing shall be given to the following students in the following order:

1. Students who live in the attendance boundaries of Santee Education Complex, Jefferson Senior High, Diego Rivera Learning Complex, Maya Angelou Community High School, and/or Manual Arts High School, up to a **maximum total of 480** students, with preference given in the following order to
 - 1) Students matriculating from Synergy Kinetic Academy
 - 2) Siblings of Synergy Quantum Academy students
 - 3) Children of employees (total # of employees' children not to exceed 10% of total enrollment of Charter School)
 - 4) Other students
2. Students who live outside of the attendance boundaries of the schools listed above with preference given in the following order to
 - 1) Students matriculating from Synergy Kinetic Academy who reside in and out of LAUSD boundaries
 - 2) Siblings of Synergy Quantum Academy students who reside within LAUSD boundaries
 - 3) Children of employees (total # of employees' children not to exceed 10% of total enrollment of Charter School) who reside within LAUSD boundaries
 - 4) Other students who reside within LAUSD boundaries,
3. Students who live outside of LAUSD, with preference given to
 - 1) Siblings of Synergy Quantum Academy students
 - 2) Children of employees (total # of employees' children not to exceed 10% of total enrollment of Charter School)
 - 3) Other students

Families do not need to be present in order for their child's name to be drawn in the lottery.

During the public random drawing, once all available spaces are filled, a waitlist will be created for each grade level by drawing all remaining applicants' names. Students will be placed on the waitlist in the order that their names were drawn during this part of the public random drawing.
