



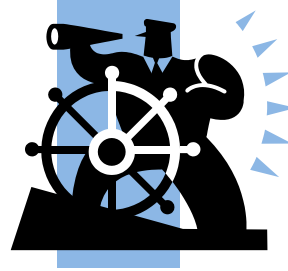
SCHOOL SUPPLIES ★ NAVIGATORS ★ (4th Grade Students)

The following are necessary classroom supplies:

LABEL WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

Package of Crayola markers (8–10)
Pair of scissors
Two Packages of Crayola colored pencils, pre-sharpened,
one to keep and one to donate

One 1" binder
One 1½" binder
Two packages of wide-rule, loose leaf paper
One folder with pockets
Two Mead 100 page, wide-ruled, hard cover composition books
12" ruler (inches and centimeters) – no folding rulers/flexible
Hand pencil sharpener
Small pencil box or pouch with three-hole punch to fit in desk
Tennis shoes for health and fitness
Inexpensive Headphones to stay at school



DO NOT LABEL

Eight glue sticks
One protractor
Four packages of pre-sharpened pencils – Ticonderoga preferred to share
One bottle of white Elmer's glue
One eraser
Two boxes of Kleenex

GIRLS – One package clear sheet protectors
BOYS – Ziplock Bags gallon or snack or sandwich size



For students new to Summit School (for portfolio):

One 3" 3-ring binder (white with clear view cover)
Two 5-tab packages of dividers or one 8-tab package of dividers
