What does the Summer Strings Camp do for beginners?

An introductory, concentrated 4-week course that prepares 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th graders—who have little to no previous string instrument playing experience—for RHE’s beginning level string orchestra class, **Andante Strings**.

Students will learn:

- Care and maintenance of string instruments
- Fundamentals of proper posture
- Fundamentals of reading and writing music
- Identification of different rhythmic components
- Left hand finger placements
- Foundations of proper bow hold and technique
- Foundations of bowing straight
- Essential musical terminology

At the end of this 4-week course, students will be performing on stage as an orchestra.

What does the Summer Strings Camp do for intermediate level students?

A vigorous 4-week course that is designed for 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th graders who have completed their first year with the RHE String Orchestra or students with at least 1 year of prior private lessons and other string orchestra experience. The focus is to expand and refine their knowledge of skills learned, and to prepare them for RHE’s intermediate level orchestra class, **Allegro Strings**.

Students will study:

- Tone development
- Advanced bow techniques
- Sight reading
- Complex rhythmic structures and subdivision
- Music history and theory
- Refined intonation and left hand postures
- Ensemble playing
- Application of dynamics
- Dictation of rhythms and simple melodies

At the end of this 4-week course, students will be performing on stage as an orchestra.
