Growth Mindset for Parents – Part 3

Redirecting Fixed Mindset Thinking:

–Redirect your child's fixed mindset statements. If you hear your child say "I am no good in math" or "I can't understand Shakespeare," point out the fixed mindset thinking and direct her/him to a growth mindset place. Remind the child that they may not understand YET, but will by asking questions, finding new strategies, setting small goals, and working hard. Two examples on redirecting a child's statement:

Child, "I am no good in math."

Parent, "You may not understand this yet, so let's practice some more."

Child, "I don't need to study, I always do well on math tests."

Parent, "Studying can help prime the brain for further growth. Maybe you should let your teacher know that these tests don't require much practice and you are ready to take on additional challenges."
