1. Go to www.ushistory.org
2. Click on Ancient Civilizations on the left side of the webpage.
3. There are a list of chapters and under each (identified by a letter) are a series of articles.
4. You will read each article for chapters 1-6 (How Do we Know?- Ancient Rome)
5. When you have finished reading the articles you will write a ½ page, single spaced, summary for each. (37 total)
6. Each summary must include a thesis statement that is a concise summary of the main point(s) of the essay. For tips on good thesis statements, you can use the following link for guidance:
