Dear Parent/Guardian:

The course selection process for the 2019-20 school year will begin soon. Counselors will be meeting with their students in small groups for pre-course selection meetings to discuss the course selection process and share information on course options and graduation requirements. Group meetings and individual appointments with counselors will occur during the following dates:

Pre-Course Selection Meetings with Counselors

October 30th & 31st	Class of 2021 - Sophomores (Science)
November 27th & 28th	Class of 2022 - Freshmen (PE, Band & Dance)
January 8th & 9th	Class of 2020 - Juniors (Science)

Course Selection Appointments with Counselors

November 1st - 20th	Register Class of 2021 - Sophomores
November 29th - December 14th	Register Class of 2022 - Freshmen
January 10th - 28th	Register Class of 2020 - Juniors

Please take time to look over the course options and graduation requirements with your student. A copy of the 2019-20 Curriculum Guide will be available on the RB website under Parents - Forms & Documents tab by October 31st. Use this guide as a resource when selecting courses. Keep in mind that we encourage a challenging curriculum, but one that still allows the student time to participate in sports, extra-curricular activities, work, and service. Copies of the pre-course selection meeting PowerPoints will also be available under the Parent - Forms & Documents tab.

Recommendations for English, Math, Science, Social Studies and World Language courses will be made by teachers based on your student's current academic performance. Rising juniors will be recommended for the CAP (College Admissions Preparation) class based on their results from the PSAT 9.

Students will be notified at least one day prior to their scheduled appointment time and **they must bring their course registration form signed by a parent or guardian.** Please be sure to select alternative classes in case of closed classes due to high numbers or due to lack of enrollment.
