### Signing Out After Exams

\*Students who would like to sign out after the exam session has ended may bring in a signed parent note.

--- These notes should be given to the teacher at the beginning of the exam session.

--- Teachers will hold on to all notes and turn them in to the office at the end of the day.

--- Example of an acceptable parent note: “Please allow (*student*) to be signed out and leave campus at the end of his/her testing session on (*day of week*), but no earlier than 11:15.”

\*Students who sign out must immediately leave campus; students with siblings at Forbush Middle School are not allowed to sign them out early (unless a parent has contacted FMS specifically).

\*Except in an emergency situation, students will not be able to sign out before the end of their testing session or prior to 11:15am each day. The office will be unable to call into classrooms. Doing so could cause a test misadministration.

\*The afternoon classes scheduled for Monday, May 20, and Tuesday, May 21 are normal, required classes and attendance will be taken. Students who do not attend these afternoon classes will receive an unexcused absence.

### Additional Reminders

\*Students should bring two #2 pencils for exams that will be taken on paper. For students who receive read aloud modifications, please bring ear buds or headphones.

\*Students who report to school on a morning in which they do NOT have an exam will report to the cafeteria during that exam period; the gym and auditorium will be closed during exam week.

\*Students may not visit other school campuses during the exam day.
