



Health Sciences Academy

The Health Sciences Academy includes rigorous courses in preparation for post-secondary education at the college and university level. A Nursing Assistant (NAS) certificate could be obtained in the Career and College Promise program through Davidson County Community College. Upon successful completion of the academy (earning a C or higher in each academy course, beginning with the Class of 2020), students may receive a white cord for graduation and will be prepared for college and career success.
