Empowering our students with skills to succeed in their changing world is the cornerstone of Dardanelle High School. A knowledgeable and dedicated team of administrators, counselors, specialist, and law enforcement assist students with matters concerning personal and social development, academic development, vocational needs to assist in career development, and health needs.

### **Personal and Social Development**

- Individual and small group counseling is provided as needed. Classroom counseling is provided through Advisory.
- Counselors consult with students, parents, school personnel, and outside agencies.
- Incidents / concerns regarding child abuse or neglect are reported as required by law.
- Referrals and recommendations are made for additional services.
- Conflict resolution services are provided through administrators, counselors, and SRO.
- Bully Prevention Program is in place.
- Suicide Awareness and Prevention Program in place.
- Personal / Social development resources available for students, parents, and other stakeholders.
- Alternative Learning Environment available to provide preparation for the High School Equivalency Exam.

### **Academic / Vocational**

- Orientation is provided for new students.
- Academic advisement and goals are established for all students.
- Varied curriculum is provided.
- Counselor's and Administrators work with Advisors on academic planning.
- Relationship between classroom performance and success in school is established.
- Parent Teacher Conferences are held in the Fall to discuss academic performance.
- Career / Academic Planning Sessions (CAPS) are held in the Spring to plan / discuss Four-Year Plans as well as Post graduation plans.
- Vocational training is provided to interested students through ATU Career Center
- Concurrent Credit courses are available through ATU, UACCM, and Advanced Placement Exams.
- Students are provided opportunities to meet with college and military recruiters as well as work force opportunities through these groups being invited to the school to speak with seniors during advisory as well as being present for Fall Parent-Teacher Conferences for both students and parents.

## **Health**

- A part time nurse helps coordinate health services for students.
- Several staff / faculty members are trained in CPR.
- Health records are kept up to date and confidential.
