KINDERGARTEN & 1ST GRADE



Summer is here! We want to ensure that you continue taking an active part in their growth for the NEXT grade level. Here are THREE BIG IDEAS to help guide you before they come back on the first day of school in August 2018, they are:

LISTEN	LEARN
<p><u>KINDERGARTEN</u>: Encourage your child to create story problems that represent addition and subtraction of small numbers. For example, "Ann had eight balloons. Then she gave three away, so she only had five left."</p> <p><u>1ST GRADE</u>: Encourage your child to create story problems to represent addition, subtraction, and comparisons. For example, "I have seven pennies. My brother has five pennies. How many pennies does he need to have the same number as I have? He needs two more pennies."</p>	<p><u>KINDERGARTEN</u>: Be sure your child has a library card. Children should select books in which they are interested to develop a passion for reading. Many libraries have book clubs and family activities that make reading fun for the entire family.</p> <p><u>1ST GRADE</u>: Start a family book club. Let different members of the family pick the book. This could be a good way to enjoy quality family time while experiencing the joy of reading together!</p>

2ND & 3RD GRADE

Summer is here! We want to ensure that you continue taking an active part in your scholar's growth for the NEXT grade level. Here are THREE BIG IDEAS to help guide you before they come back on the first day of school in August.

LISTEN	LEARN
<p><u>2ND GRADE</u>: Encourage your child to stick with it whenever a problem seems difficult. This will help your child see that everyone can learn math.</p> <p><u>3RD GRADE</u>: Use everyday objects to allow your child to explore the concept of fractions. For example, when cooking, use measuring cups to have students demonstrate how many 1/3's are in a whole cup, how many 1/4 cups you need to make 1 1/4 cups, and how many times you have to refill a 1/2 cup measure to make 1 1/2 cups.</p>	<p><u>2ND GRADE</u>: Provide time and space for your child to read independently. This reading time should be free from distractions such as television. The Escondido Public Library is a great place to escape the summer heat. Here's a link to the procedure for getting a library card: https://library.escondido.org/librarycard.aspx</p> <p><u>3RD GRADE</u>: Ask your child what topics, events, or activities he or she likes. Look for books, magazines, or other materials about those topics that would motivate your child to read. The librarian can help find interesting reading materials in your scholar's reading ability range.</p>

4TH & 5TH GRADE



Summer is here! We want to ensure that you continue taking an active part in your scholar's growth to prepare them for the *next* grade level. Here are THREE BIG IDEAS to help guide you before coming back on the first day of school in August:

LISTEN	LEARN
<p><u>4TH GRADE:</u> Ask your child create and describe equal fractions. For example, have students take a sheet of paper, fold the paper in half, and then unfold and shade 1/2. Then have students take the same sheet of paper and fold the paper in a half again. Unfold the paper and have students discuss the number of parts that are now shaded. Encourage your child to talk about ways to show that $1/2 = 2/4$. (Students may continue this process creating other equal fractions.)</p> <p><u>5TH GRADE:</u> Ask your child to give you a fraction equal to a decimal. For example, what are two fractions that can be used to represent 0.6? Answers could include 6/10, 60/100, 12/20 , or 3/5.</p>	<p><u>4TH GRADE:</u> Ask your child what he or she learned from reading a book they checked out from the library and how that knowledge can be used in real life. Have him or her read the most interesting or useful sections aloud.</p> <p><u>5TH GRADE:</u> Assist your child in using references like the Internet or a dictionary to look up unfamiliar words.</p>

4TH & 5TH GRADE

Explore San Diego by challenging your student to answer this science question:

QUESTION: How can water, ice, wind, and vegetation change the land?

EXPLORE: Go to Dixon Lake or San Elijo's nearly 1,000 acre lagoon, bring some snacks and your camera to take pictures of the natural wildlife. Hike through the rustic hiking trails or rent a boat. Make a video of your experience or write a short story from the perspective of one of the animals you saw.

Summer is here! We want to ensure that you continue taking an active part in your scholar's growth for the NEXT grade level. Here are THREE BIG IDEAS to help guide you before they come back on the first day of school in August 2018, they are:

LISTEN	LEARN
<p><u>6TH GRADE:</u> Ask your child to calculate the unit rates of items purchased from the grocery store. For example, if 2 pounds of flour cost \$3.00, how much does flour cost per pound?</p> <p><u>7TH GRADE:</u> Use store advertisements to engage your child in working with numbers. For example, if a store advertises 30% off, have your child estimate the dollar amount of the discount, as well as the sale price of an item.</p>	<p><u>6TH-7TH GRADE:</u> Visit museums, zoos, theaters, historical sites, aquariums, and other educational places to help increase your child's exposure to new knowledge and vocabulary. Discuss current events, shared interests, and future aspirations for education and career.</p>
