Please refer to our Family Handbook on page 29.

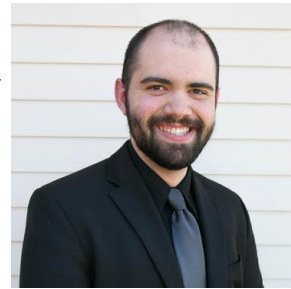

If your child leaves campus, this ends their school day and therefore they cannot be signed into BASS later in the afternoon. Remember BASS is an extension of the school day program and not a daycare.

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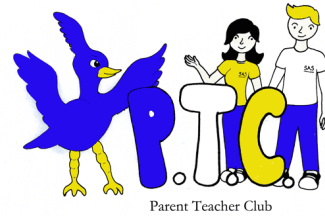
