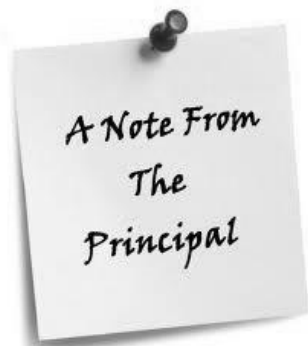
Office Hours:
