Tennessee Promise:

To be eligible for the scholarship, students must meet the following deadlines and requirements:

- Apply to the program by November 1, 2018.
- File the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by January 15, 2019 at www.fafsa.gov.
- Attend two mandatory meetings led by the local partnering organization. Failure to attend will result in loss of Tennessee Promise.
- Complete and submit 8 hours of community service for each semester to maintain eligibility. The initial community service must be completed and submitted by July 1, 2019.
- Apply to and enroll in an eligible institution.
- Submit documentation for FAFSA verification, if required by the student's institution, by August 1, 2019.
