Coldspring Trojans win the District Basketball Championship

Our Coldspring Trojans have won the 23-3A District Basketball Championship for the second year in a row.

The winning game was a nail-biter that came down to the final seconds, ending with a 71-69 win over the Hempstead Bobcats on Friday, Feb. 1.

The Trojans Varsity wrapped up the regular season 29-2 overall, and 10-0 in district play. The JV went undefeated, 17-0, for the year.

This season also marked Trojans Coach Greg Deviers' 300th win as a high school basketball coach. That's a lot of wins!

The Lady Trojans placed 2nd in District and also made it to the play-offs. It will be the Lady Trojans versus the Palacios Sharquettes on Tuesday, Feb. 12, at Stafford High School. Tip-off is at 7 p.m. Tickets are \$5 for adults and \$3 for students. All passes will be accepted. See you there!

Black History Month Profile: Charles Hamilton Houston

Known as “The Man Who Killed Jim Crow,” Charles Hamilton Houston was a groundbreaking attorney and law professor whose brilliant legal strategy ultimately resulted in the desegregation of American schools, among other achievements.

Born in Washington D.C. in 1895 to middle-class parents, Houston attended segregated local schools and graduated from Amherst College as valedictorian in 1915. After his experience as an officer in the U.S. Army during World War I, Houston decided to study law in order to fight for “men who could not strike back.” He attended Harvard and became the first African



American to serve as editor of the Harvard Law Review. In the 1930s, Houston became the first special counsel to the NAACP, and was involved in the majority of civil rights cases until his death in 1950.

Houston trained and mentored a generation of African American attorneys, including Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall. His legacy continues to fight for good.
