

BYOD AGREEMENT

1. Devices must be in silent mode while in school buildings, unless directed otherwise by your instructor.
2. Devices may not be used to cheat or gain an unfair advantage on assignments or tests, or for non-instructional purposes (such as making personal phone calls, texting, etc..)
3. Devices may not be used to record, transmit, or post photographic images or video of a person or persons on campus during school activities/hours. Nor can any images or video recorded at school be transmitted or posted at any time without the expressed permission of all persons involved. (This statement is in accordance with Pennsylvania State Law and a violation could result in legal action.)
4. Students may use device to access files on computer or internet sites which are relevant to the classroom curriculum.
5. Device may only be used during class(es) with teacher permission for instructional activities and must be stored immediately upon the direction of the teacher.
6. Non-educational games are not permitted.
7. Students must comply with teacher/staff request to shut down devices or close the screen. Use of personal computing devices by students, staff, or guests is not to be disruptive to classroom activities or the student's learning. Phone conversations and use of text in order to facilitate face-to-face interaction are NOT permitted at any time.
8. The use of Google Docs, Edmodo, Moodle, blogs, podcasts, or other Web 2.0 tools are considered an extension of the classroom. Therefore, any speech that is considered inappropriate in the classroom is also inappropriate in all uses of blogs, podcasts, or other Web 2.0 tools.
9. Violations of any policy, administrative procedures, or school rules involving a student's personally owned device may result in the loss in the privilege of use of the device in school and/or disciplinary action.
10. During school hours the student may only use his/her device to access classroom related activities.
11. The school's network filters will be applied to one's connection to the internet and no attempt will be made to bypass them.
12. Bringing onto the premises or infecting the network with a Virus, Trojan, or program designed to damage, alter, destroy, or provide access to unauthorized data or information is strictly prohibited and may result in your device being blocked from the network and/or legal prosecution.
13. Processing or accessing information on school property related to "hacking", altering, or bypassing network security policies is strictly prohibited.
14. The school has the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected to be the source of an attack or virus infection.
15. The school reserves the right to inspect a student's personal device if there is a reason to believe that the student has violated the school's policies, administrative procedures, school rules, or has engaged in other misconduct while using her personal device.
16. Files pertaining to school work must be saved on the hard drive of a laptop, a jump drive, an external drive, or using a cloud-based application or service and the school is not responsible for lost or incorrectly saved work.
17. Printing from personal laptops will not be possible at school.
18. Personal technology is to be charged PRIOR to bringing it to school and is to run off its own battery at school.
19. The school will NOT provide for technical support of any kind.
