Fullerton School celebrated World Read Aloud Day last week by inviting guest readers to come to school and read in classrooms.

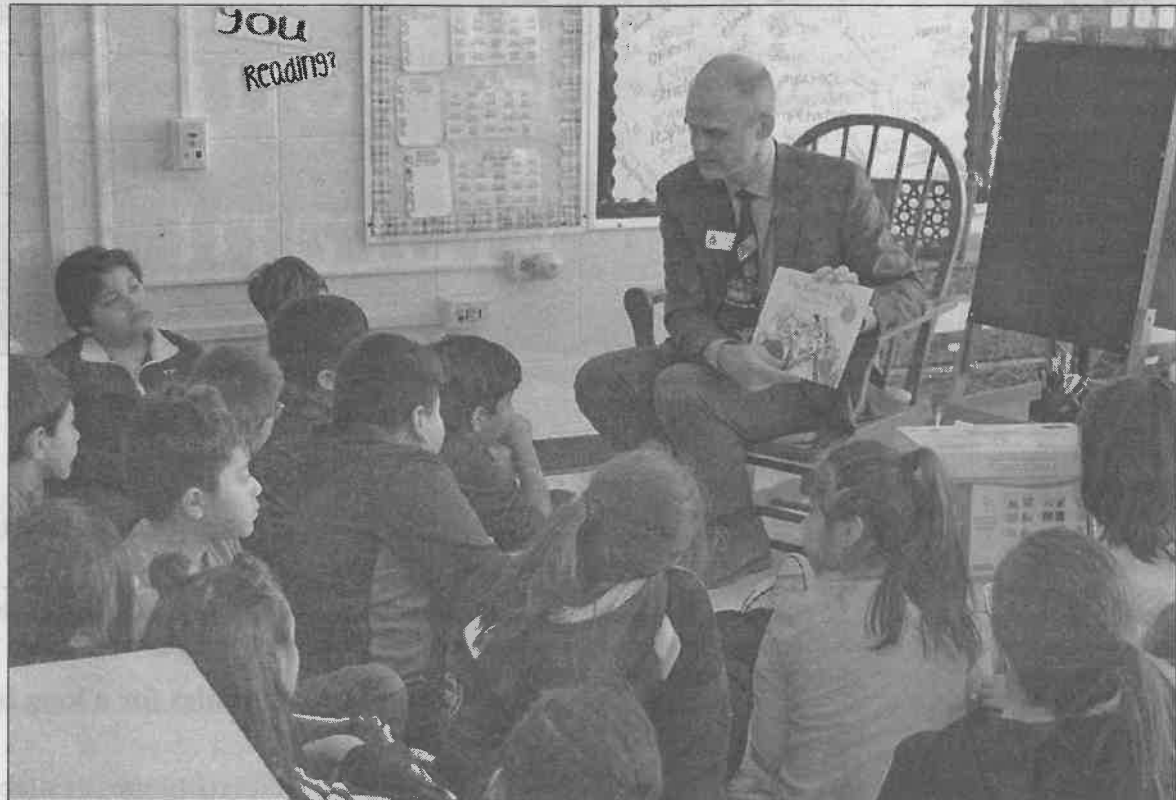
Readers included members of the Addison Police Department and Addison Fire Protection District, District 4 administrators and staff, and community members.
