OBLIGATIONS

There will be TWO postings of financial obligations.

FIRST POSTING OF SENIOR OBLIGATIONS

May 1, 2019

Seniors who have lost or damaged school equipment or supplies (i.e., textbooks, library books, science equipment, athletic uniforms or equipment, etc.) and have not paid for them will find their names and the amount due on the Obligation List. The obligation list will be posted on the campus bulletin boards and will be available in the Main Office, the Student Store, and Library.

Tickets for the graduation ceremony, as well as the diploma, will be withheld until the debt is paid. Seniors are encouraged to clear their obligations and pay the amount due at the Student Store as soon as possible. The second posting of senior obligations will cover second-semester obligations, in addition to unpaid obligations from the first posting.

LAST POSTING OF SENIOR OBLIGATIONS

May 31, 2019

The updated Obligations List, including charges for the second semester, will be posted at 8:00 am. Seniors should take care of their obligations promptly so that their tickets and diplomas may be released.

All obligations due May 31, 2019 must be paid in cash or money order. A receipt will be issued upon payment.

*******Again, a reminder. Seniors will NOT be allowed to participate in graduation without clearing all financial obligations through the Student Store. *******

Herff Jones's graduation product delivery date is Tuesday, May 21, 2019. Seniors will pick up their gowns from the Counselor check in tables in Sea King Park at lunch. Check the cap and gown package to make sure it is complete. Cap and gown packages should include a cap, gown, tassel and medallion. If something is missing or the size seems wrong, call Dallas Moon at (805) 716-027 or email moongradservices@gmail.com. If your student purchased the gown, cap, tassel and medallion, he or she will keep all of those items after Graduation. If your student requested a loaner, then the gown, cap, tassel and medallion must all be returned to the Herff Jones representatives immediately following Graduation outside of Room 301. Diplomas will not be given to students who requested loaners until the loaner gowns, caps, tassels and medallions are returned immediately following Graduation. Once all 4 items are returned, students receive a receipt, verifying the return. Counselors will give diplomas to students once they show their gown return receipt.

Seniors will line up at the BAND ROOM at 9:15 a.m. for check in and to load the bus. You will ride the same bus with the same people TO and FROM Disneyland. There is no driving separately and no staying later. No food or drink will be allowed onto the bus. Please plan accordingly and eat breakfast before you arrive and bring money for lunch later. Additionally, no backpacks

or large purses will be allowed. You will have to pass through security in order to load the busses.

Please see the enclosed permission slips and information sheet regarding Senior Day. The permission slip is due along with the check for Senior Day by May 1st to the Student Store. The cost for senior day is \$130.00 and includes transportation to Disneyland. **The deadline for turning in field trip slips and full payment is May 1, 2019. SPACE IS LIMITED and BUSES are limited! BUY YOUR TICKET EARLY!!!** Please understand that seniors **must** attend either Senior Day at Disneyland **or** attend school. For students not attending Senior Day, absences will be handled in the regular manner.

Because of complicated insurance and liability regulations, seniors may not join the class at Disneyland unless they have purchased a ticket and have arrived at Disneyland with the group. Use of private transportation is not permitted to or from Disneyland.

It is appropriate to send money for the day with your child. We have found that \$50 is sufficient for food and souvenirs as well as any activities that they wish to partake in. You may wish to encourage your child to bring sunscreen, a hat and a sweatshirt or sweater.

Handicapped seating is in front of Room 317. There will be a student usher to check you in, but the tickets do not differ and they come out of the allotted 6 per student.

The Prom, a formal dinner dance, will be held at The University of Southern California's Wallis Annenberg Building. The ticket price includes a buffet dinner, soda bar, and dessert bar, all taxes and gratuities in addition to the dance. Tickets are sold per person.

If your date is **not** a student of Palos Verdes High School, you **must** complete a Guest Pass Form, which is available at the Student Store. Guest Passes must be complete and submitted when you buy your ticket. Guest passes must be approved before tickets can be purchased.

Peninsula and Rancho Del Mar students DO NOT need a Guest Pass. **ALL STUDENTS MUST PRESENT A VALID SCHOOL I.D. AT THE DOOR!!!**

Dinner, dessert and complimentary soft drinks will be served to all students in attendance. There is a fee for parking. Picture packages and other items of a personal nature are not included in the price of the ticket. Admission to the Prom is by ticket only. Tickets will be sold at the Student Store 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The dinner is a buffet, and students may eat at their convenience between 8:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. **Please note that the doors to the Prom will close at 9 p.m. and we ask that everyone remain until the prom court is crowned at 10:00 p.m.**

FINAL EXAMS FOR SENIORS

Activity Date: June 3-6, 2019

Location: Individual Classrooms

1. Seniors who fail a class as a result of failing a final exam may not meet graduation requirements. In that event, their counselor will notify them.
2. Seniors who do not meet the graduation requirements may participate in the graduation exercises under certain conditions. Note: Board of Education Administrative Regulation 2127 states (effective Class of 1981):

“To be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony, students shall have satisfied the credit, subject and competency requirements contained in Board Policy 2122 (Credit, Subject and Competency Requirements for High School Graduation). The only exceptions to this provision shall be students who have five or fewer credits remaining to be completed, who are eligible to complete such credits in the immediately ensuing summer session, and who have obtained the advance approval of the Principal. With the approval of the Principal, a senior who has not satisfied all requirements for graduation shall nonetheless be permitted to participate in senior activities.”

BACCALAUREATE AND SENIOR AWARDS

Activity Date: June 2, 2019

All seniors and parents are cordially invited to attend Baccalaureate exercises.

1. **Seniors will be dressed formally in appropriate baccalaureate and graduation attire (see below).** Cords and medallions may be worn.
2. **Seniors are asked to be in the MPR by 4:00 p.m.** so that the processional and recessional may be arranged.
3. The Baccalaureate ceremony will last approximately one and a half hours. All students are highly encouraged to attend. This is a very student-centered ceremony, and is more informal than graduation. The ceremony offers an ideal opportunity for entire families to celebrate the graduating seniors' accomplishments without the crowds or rush of graduation.
4. Seniors who will be receiving Senior Awards will be notified by the CCC.
5. Tickets are not needed to Baccalaureate but for handicapped parking or seating information, please contact Mrs. Maxfield at maxfieldj@pvpusd.net.

REQUIRED DRESS FOR GRADUATES AT BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATION:

Men

- Hard soled shoes or dress shoes (no tennis shoes, athletic shoes, sandals, boots, slippers or flip flops)
- Dress shirt and tie, long pants or slacks (no jeans)
- Graduation Gown and Cords (Caps ONLY to Graduation)

Women

- Hard soled shoes or dress shoes (no tennis shoes, athletic shoes, sandals, boots, slippers or flip flops)
- Skirt or blouse, dress or appropriate pants (no jeans or Capri style)
- No halter tops or shorts, or bare midriffs
- Graduation Gown and Cords (Caps ONLY to Graduation)

MANDATORY GRADUATION REHEARSAL (NO EXCEPTIONS)

Activity Date: June 5, 2019

12:30-2:30 p.m.

Location: Sea King Park

1. Seniors are asked to report to Sea King Park promptly at 1:00 pm where instruction will be given to the entire class. Your child does not need to bring his/her cap and gown for the rehearsal.
2. The rehearsal will proceed smoothly and on schedule if all seniors cooperate fully in following the directions. Graduation rehearsal normally lasts 1½ - 2 hours.
3. **Seniors with jobs must make advance arrangements with their employers to attend the rehearsal.**

DISTRIBUTION OF GRADUATION TICKETS

1. Each senior will be given six (6) tickets on the day of grad rehearsal.
2. Students who do not need their entire allotment of six tickets are asked to make Mrs. Delorenzo aware of that as soon as possible, so that extra tickets can be given to those who need them. Extra tickets will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
3. Remember that clearance of obligations is a prerequisite to receiving graduation tickets.
4. Tickets will be distributed following graduation rehearsal – you must be at the rehearsal in order to get your tickets.
5. Handicapped parking passes will be sent with the tickets. Handicapped seating tickets DO NOT differ.

(Please read the note concerning Board of Education Administrative Regulation 2127 under "Final Exams for Seniors" in this bulletin regarding qualifications for participation in the ceremony.)

All tickets to the commencement exercises for parents and guests will be given to each graduating senior on Wednesday, June 6, 2018, after graduation rehearsal. Seniors must be cleared of all accumulated obligations before tickets are issued (e.g. transcript charges, lost textbooks/library books, athletic uniforms, classroom supplies, parking permits, etc.).

Seniors will park on the utility fields below and report to their designated tents on the blacktop by the gym for the processional no later than 4:45 PM.

We will read the names of graduates from two microphones. Yells, cheers, or other inappropriate noise after a student's name is read completely drowns out the name of the next student receiving a diploma. Not only does the noise disturb others, it robs another family of their right to hear the name of their graduate. These selfish actions on the part of a few have literally ruined graduation for some families in past years.

You are respectfully requested not to permit your family or guests to distract from a beautiful and meaningful ceremony.

Graduation, while not a formal occasion, is a ceremony of dignity, and guests are expected to dress and act appropriately. Standing on chairs to take pictures or approaching the stage area at any time during the ceremony is both dangerous and an irritation to those whose view is blocked and is forbidden. BALLOONS, floral arrangements, confetti cannons and noise-makers are NOT permitted into Sea King Park!

Parents and friends are urged to complete picture-taking sessions as quickly as possible after the ceremony ends. The actual diploma will not be issued until after the ceremony and will be released only to the graduating senior. Diplomas will be distributed following the ceremony in counseling office. Borrowed Gowns and NHS stoles must be returned following graduation outside of room 301.

If your student does not wish to pick up his/her diploma after the Graduation ceremony, he/she may come to the Counseling Office on Monday, June 10, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. and pick it up. However, if your student is unavailable, you must have a note from your child that clearly states you have permission to pick up his/her diploma. Your child's diploma belongs to him/her and can only be released to you with his/her permission.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY AT GRADUATION

We know that most families want souvenir photos of their son or daughter at graduation. The senior class has hired professionals to photograph each graduate as he or she receives the diploma and Live from 205 will produce a DVD that will highlight the graduation ceremony, baccalaureate and senior breakfast.

This procedure ELIMINATES:

Dozens of “Parent Photographers/Video Operators” standing

- in the way of the graduates
- on the steps
- on, in front of, and behind the stage
- in or amongst the band

Dozens of complaints during and after the ceremony about:

- photographers blocking the view of the audience
- family photographers spoiling the shot of the professional photographers
- the noise as photographers reposition students for a better pose
- the shouting of instructions to students to “smile,” “slow down,” “wait a second,” etc.
- the inability of guests to see the student or hear the name of the graduate at the moment of receiving the diploma

Please consult additional attachments that hold additional details concerning cost, ordering procedure and delivery for the handshake photos. DVDs will be mailed home via the form provided in this bulletin.

This procedure will give us a ceremony that is both dignified and appropriate. It eliminates confusion and permits all guests to hear without the distractions. We appreciate your cooperation and compliance.

RULE: We will not permit any photographers (family or otherwise) to approach the stage during the ceremony for any reason. Of course, we will permit pictures as the graduating class enters the Sea King Park, however you **MUST REMAIN** seated. The stage will be left in order following the ceremony so family pictures may be taken. The rule is simple...**we do not want anyone to leave his or her seat to take pictures during the ceremony.**

Photographers, please be considerate of those around you. We ask that photographers do not stand in front of our elderly and handicapped guests in order to take photographs. This is completely inappropriate, and we respectfully request that it not occur. In addition, photographers are requested not to cross the barriers between the graduates and the crowd until after the ceremony.

In Conclusion:

This is a very fun time of year for seniors, but potentially a very dangerous time. The biggest concerns are the Prom and Senior Excursion. However, any drug or alcohol involvement (use, possession, selling, and possession of drug paraphernalia) at school or a school sponsored activity falls into the same category. Drug and alcohol infractions call for a suspension and 8 weeks social probation which prohibits students from participating in all school activities, including Prom, Senior Day, Baccalaureate and Graduation. Check the calendar. Both the Prom and Senior Excursion fall within this time period. If students violate these rules, forget about participation in the graduation day ceremony. We are sorry that relatives planned to fly in from across the country. The stakes are very high. **IF STUDENTS CANNOT FOLLOW THESE RULES, THEY SHOULD NOT ATTEND THE PROM OR SENIOR DAY!**

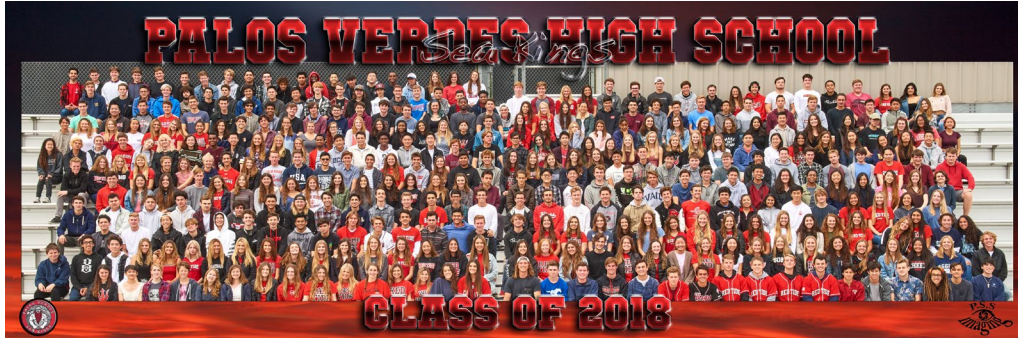
