



Health Record Requirements 2018-2019

Please review and complete the following Health Records which are required each year. **All forms are due by Monday, July 9, 2018.** The following forms are required on all returning and new students.

School Entrance Requirements:

The Health Record (*completed by the parent /guardian*) must be updated each year. Allergies (food, insect stings, and medications, latex, seasonal or other) should be listed. Medications (needed at school and taken at home) should be listed. Please mark on the form if an *EpiPen, Inhaler, or Insulin* is needed at school. Please submit to the School office any Allergy/ Asthma Action Plan (*Food, Allergy, Asthma or other*) and emergency medication prior to the start of school. The Health Information and Treatment Release Statement must be signed.

The Physical Exam Form (*completed by the physician*) may be printed off but must have a hand written signature from the healthcare provider. **This is required for NEW students only.** NEW and RETURNING students must have had an exam conducted, and on file, in the 12 months prior to the opening of school. Included on the Physical Exam Form are the following State of Texas required screenings (needed for specific grades) to be completed by your healthcare provider:

- Vision Screening on all students entering grades PK4, K, 1st, 3rd and all new students
- Hearing Screening on all students entering grades PK4, K, 1st, 3rd and all new students
- Diabetes Screening (Type 2/visual neck screening) on all students entering grades 1st, 3rd, 5th

Vision and Hearing Form must be submitted for returning students entering grades PK4, K, 1st, and 3rd.

Immunizations must be current and a copy on file as required by the State. This form is not provided by school; please obtain from your physician. *Proof of Varicella vaccine or chicken pox disease must be on file.*

Emergency Sheet MUST be in the School's possession before the first day of school. This must be complete and accurate for the utmost safety of your child.

A parent or guardian must sign the Health Record and Emergency Sheet. *Forms that are not signed are considered incomplete and will be returned. Students will not be permitted to attend school, participate in physical education, recess, sports or extracurricular activities until these forms are signed and returned to the Ascension Episcopal School office.*
