Dear Parent/Guardian:

On behalf of the high school staff and administration we hope you have enjoyed the summer break. We are excited to begin the 2019-2020 school year as we are finishing up last minute details for the return of students on Thursday, August 22, 2019. Below is some important information for you to know so that your child can be as prepared as possible for the upcoming school year.

Chromebooks this year will be distributed on the first day of school. Enclosed are the pages to be completed and returned in order for your student to receive a Chromebook. If choosing insurance, a payment of \$30.00 will be needed at that time (refer to the Chromebook Initiative found on the KAHS website for an outline of the Protection Plan). A check, money order or cash will be accepted. If a Credit Card payment was made, a receipt will need to be turned in in order for your student to receive a Chromebook.

Parking Passes will be available for pick-up each day starting August 13, 2019. Please come to the Front Office and see Mrs. Frock or Miss Hill between the hours of 9 to 11am and 1 to 3 pm. All paperwork and copies must be completed and submitted along with a check, money order or cash before a Parking Pass will be issued. If a Credit Card payment was made, a receipt will need to be turned in in order for your student to receive a Parking Pass. If an obligation from a previous school year has not been met, you are not permitted to get a parking pass until the obligation has been fulfilled. The Parking Pass Application can be found on the KAHS website.

Google forms must be completed for both the Chromebook Agreement and the Parking Pass Application. All information can be found on the KAHS website.

On Wednesday, August 14, 2019, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am, the high school will be open for all new students and incoming 9th graders to tour the facility and once again get acclimated to the high school.
