2019-20 Incoming Kindergarten Registration

Your child must be five years old on or before July 31st in order to enter kindergarten. Registration begins February 1st, 2019. Kindly remind your family, friends, neighbors with children living in our school district they can register at the school. Office will accept registration from 8:30am to 3:30pm. Kindly bring the following documents:

1. Child's birth certificate
2. Proof of residency in Royal School's catchment area
3. **Original Form 14**, revised 2014 (immunization record)
4. **TB Clearance** (date given and date read must be within 1 year of the child's testing date.)
5. Foreign students must include a passport or Visa printed in English
