- I. Call the Meeting to Order: Rosemary called the meeting to order at 3:19pm**

 - a. Review and approval of minutes: Lisa House moved and Kenny Zavala seconded.

- VII. New Business: Legal Requirements:**
 - a. EL Parent Meeting—The Road to Reclassification: Counselors reviewed the Road to Reclassification at parent meeting last week. We reviewed the overall score, domains and passing criteria of the ELPAC at the meeting. They also shared the requirements for SBAC or iReady. Dr. Salehi shared that 8th graders who received a qualifying grade in PSAT can also qualify to reclassify. He shared the "2018-2019 Road to Reclassification Report" for individual students that were given to parents that was tailored to specific students. Dr. Salehi shared they have to meet the qualification in all sections of the ELPAC to reclassify.
 - b. R-FEP Follow-up Monitoring Meetings: Dr. Salehi shared the reclassification form given to parents for 2 years after they have reclassified to ensure students get the support they need since they no longer get ELD. He shared students who reclassify generally do better than English only students.
 - c. Activities to Build Parent Capacity: Dr. Salehi shared all of the sessions with Coffee with the Counselors and ELAC to encourage parent involvement.
 - d. SWP annual review - Evaluation of Title I programs/services: Dr. Salehi shared the protocol. Analyzing the SBAC data, Carolyn Nord noticed that the EL subgroup did not have a significant progress in SBAC. One of the things we did this year was to strategically place students in support classes. Counselors are on top of the data and share it with the iReady teachers. We also have the iReady tool box to support students. Cecilia Quintero asked if there was an award ceremony for students that reclassified. Dr. Salehi shared that we will include it in the award ceremony. Mrs. Mayes shared that students are recognized in their classes with their peers, but it is a great idea to share in celebration with parents too. Dr. Salehi shared that students who don't reclassify, don't get to take the electives they want in high school since they take ELD. The students say the teachers encourage them to do well on the testing. Dr. Salehi shared that the district did a SBAC data comparison with similar schools in California. In terms of progress for SBAC, our students were in 96%tile in ELA and 83%tile in Math.

VIII. Reports:

- a. ELAC/DELAC-The road to reclassification was shared with parents in the ELAC meeting. ELAC provided advice for SSC regarding parent involvement.
- b. AVID: Mrs. House shared that tutors want to be involved in the AVID meeting so they can be involved in the planning and procedural process. Dr. Salehi shared there are 20+ teachers who have gone or will go to specific training for AVID at the district.
- c. Magnet: Enrique Gonzales shared that students are working on advertisements about how to help the planet and make useful items to keep our planet green.
- d. High School Visit 8th Grade: Kenny asked if students can attend the fieldtrip to either high school. Dr. Salehi shared that in December students will go on a fieldtrip to the high school based on the boundaries. There is an evening event on the same day that students and parents can attend for the school of their choice. They can get a transfer permit to go to another school in January during open enrollment.
