**Adulting 101**—*Ages 16-25*—Basic life skills workshops in partnership with Kaiser Permanente's Center for Healthy Living.

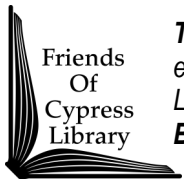
**Book Chat Group**—*Adults*—"Every Note Played" by Lisa Genova.
