 <p>Step 1</p>	<p>Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov or Dream Act https://dream.csac.ca.gov before March 2nd</p> <p>*Create an FSA ID and use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool *Check status on the website under “My FAFSA”</p>
 <p>Step 2</p>	<p>Check your email and review your Student Aid Report (SAR) carefully for completion</p> <p>The SAR tells you:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Your application was submitted2. What your family may be paying AKA Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)3. If you were selected for verification
 <p>Step 3</p>	<p>Review your Student Aid Report (SAR) carefully for accuracy and make necessary recommendations</p> <p>*See College Boost, your counselor, or Ms. Wu for help with making corrections</p>
 <p>Step 4</p>	<p>Complete any additional requirements by the deadline indicated on your portal email</p> <p>*Check your College Student Portal or contact the financial aid office at the college you will attend to find out about additional requirements</p>
