Parking Lot Safety

Please be mindful that it is essential for us to be safety conscious in the parking lot at PVE. By remembering a few safety items, we can keep everyone out of harm's way.

- Please drive slowly and cautiously in the parking lot.

- If you walk your student up to the door, you will need to go to the office and sign your child in for the day.
- Please have your child exit the car from the side that is closest to the curb.

Immunizations

School immunization requirements are determined by the Indiana State Department of Health. All accredited public and accredited non-public schools are required to verify the immunization status of each student to the Indiana Department of Education. You are required to provide documentation of a medical or religious exemption to the school. A new religious exemption must be filed every year.

The State of Indiana allows 30 days or your child will be excluded from school until the medical requirements are met. Your child must receive the required immunizations and provide documentation to the school.

If your child's immunizations are not up-to-date, please contact your primary health care provider or local health department to schedule an appointment to get the immunization(s).
