The district closed for the 4th of July and gave a much needed break to custodians, office staff, and administrators. We reopened on July 8 to a new year of Little Vikings that are busting at the seams, the Central School boiler project, new seal coat for JRSRHS parking lots, a new ADA ramp installed at the Gordon W. Mitchell School, IT work at all buildings, and of course daily deliveries of instructional equipment and supports for students and teachers.

Mr. Jeff Sylvia has joined the Vikings as the new EBJSHS Principal and will be holding a meet and greet on July 30, 2019 at 6pm in the auditorium. He will be joined by Mr. Matt Bosh, the new EBJSHS Assistant Principal; together they will instill a culture and climate of support and collaboration for ALL students and teachers.

Dr. Williams offered several mini-grants for faculty to continue work on schedules, curriculum, and continued development of the Universal Design Model that the district will be diving into in the fall.

John Phelan, Special Education Director is busy making sure all students that have individual education plans can reach their full potential. He also is working on transitional programming for our older students as well as creating opportunities here in the district to bring back a few out of district placed students.

John Shea worked with Chief Allen and we have been awarded a \$45,000 safety grant for the Gordon W. Mitchell School to upgrade cameras and fob system. Working together collaboratively to write grants supports the district's initiative on safety as well as relieving the financial burden on the town!

We are negotiating a new contract with the EBEA and hope to settle before the new school year begins!

Transportation is in final stages of getting out bus routes, athletic signups are open, school bucks is ready, and again if you need anything do not hesitate to call us, WE ARE HERE FOR YOU!
