Mindfulness for Children

At each developmental stage, mindfulness can be a useful tool for decreasing anxiety and promoting happiness. Mindfulness--a simple technique that emphasizes paying attention to the present moment in an accepting, nonjudgmental manner--has emerged as a popular mainstream practice in recent decades.

Stop. Just take a momentary pause, no matter what you're doing.

Take a breath. Feel the sensation of your own breathing, which brings you back to the present moment.

Observe. Acknowledge what is happening, for good or bad, inside you or out. Just note it.

Proceed. Having briefly checked in with the present moment, continue with whatever it was you were doing.

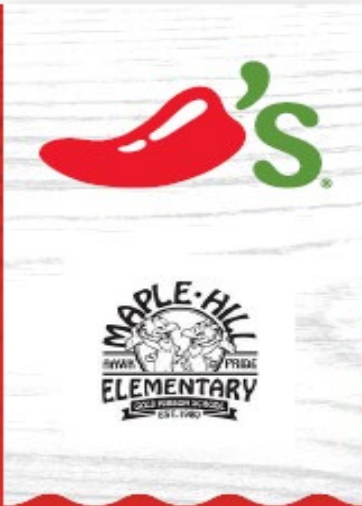

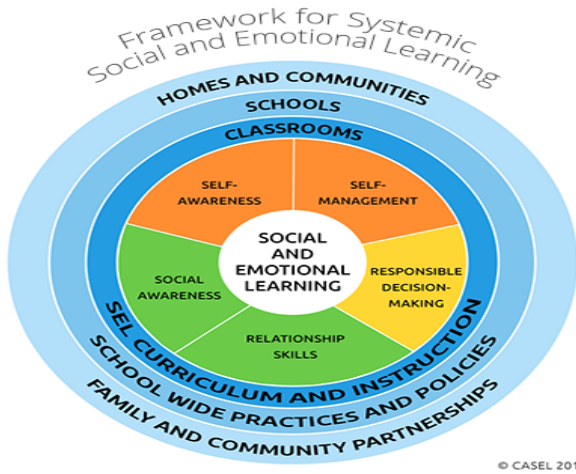

At the Parent Night, you will learn more about:

- The importance of developing a social and emotional child.
 - Especially in the areas of self-awareness, self-regulation, motivation, empathy, and social skills
- Help your child learn to regulate emotions and calm themselves down.
- Learn how to get your child to talk to you about their inner feelings.
- And much, much more!
