



Shady Grove Pre-K and Kinder Round-Up

Welcome to Shady Grove Elementary, home of the Bull-pups!!! This is an exciting time for both parents and students. We want to make sure that the registration process goes as smoothly as possible. Below is a list of the required documents that we will need to register your student. If you have further questions, please feel free to contact our school at: 512-756-2126.

Pre-K and Kinder Registration will be held at Shady Grove in the Library on Tuesday April 23, 2019 during the hours of: 10:00 am – 1:00 pm , and 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm.

- Incoming Pre-K students must be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2019
- Incoming Kinder students must be 5 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2019

What do I need to register my child?

- Proof of residence within the district (contract on house, lease agreement, or utility bill that has the address and the adult's name)
- Identification of person enrolling student
- Child's official birth certificate (hospital birth certificates will NOT be accepted)
- Child's current immunization record
- Child's social security card (preferred but will not prevent enrollment)
- Proof of eligibility for all Pre-K students (see requirements below)

In order to complete your child's registration, the above documents must be provided to the campus prior to the first day of school.

What will qualify my student for Pre-K?

Our Pre-K is an **ALL DAY** federally funded program. Students must meet **1 of the 5** criteria below in order to attend:

- **Income** – We will need to see the last 30 days of the household income. We will receive our new 2019-2020 income guidelines the first week in August and we will then be able to confirm if your student is eligible for Pre-K attendance.
- **Military** – One of the parents of the student was in Active Military and was injured or killed in the line of duty.
- **Foster Care** – The child has been or is currently in the conservatorship of DFPS.
- **Language** – The student's second language is English. Your student will be tested prior to being accepted into our Pre-K program.
- **Texas Star Award** – If one of the child's parents are eligible for the Texas Star Award as:
 - a. a peace officer under section 3106.002
 - b. a firefighter under section 3601.003
 - c. an emergency medical first responder under section 3106.004
