The Phlebotomy Technician I program prepares graduates for entry-level positions as phlebotomists in hospitals, clinics, Laboratory Service Centers and physician's offices.

Our LFS/DHS approved CPTI programs include 48 hours of lecture and 40 hours of practical experience at nearby externship sites for students with no work experience or "Advanced" 48 hours of lecture for students with phlebotomy experience. Upon successful completion of the program, our students will have met all of California State's requirements to become a Certified Phlebotomy Technician I, including the completion of an approved national online examination.
