Meeting called to order at 3:16 PM.

- Flag Salute
 - Dr. Usmani welcomed all new members to SSC, then led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.
- Public Comments
 - No public comments offered.
- SPSA
 - Dr. Usmani led discussion on school's progress towards schools's measurable objectives from 2017-18 school year as stated on the SPSA Evaluation:
 - DMHS met its goal of increasing its graduation rate by 2% from 95% to 97% by June 2018 as measured by the School Report Card.

- DMHS did not meet its goal of increasing its proficiency levels on ELA SBAC by 2% from 94% to 96% for all subgroups by June 2018 as measured by the School Report Card.
- DMHS did not meet its goal of increasing the percentage of English Learners scoring basic or higher on the Reading Inventory from 29% to 39%.
- SSC discussed strategies to increase percentage of parents participating in the School Experience Survey after learning that the school did not meet its goal of increasing percentage of parents from 34% to 44%. Ideas included: a visual indicating progress of parent participation, Chipotle incentives, etc.
- School did not meet its attendance goal of increasing attendance by 2% from 90% of students with a 96% or higher attendance rate to a 92% attendance rate. Attendance rate for last year among all grade-level students was 85.5%. At present, the school is on track to meet its attendance goal. Ideas to increase participation included providing parents resources related to flu vaccination; attendance reminders via texts, robocalls, etc.; etc.
- Oh made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Magandy seconded. All voted in favor to adjourn the meeting.
