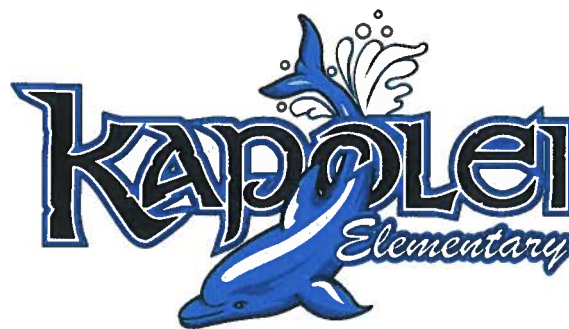

Fall Is Here!

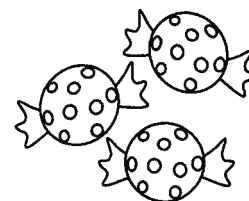
The second quarter officially begins on October 15, 2018.

Question: Where can I find the most up to date information about Kapolei Elementary?

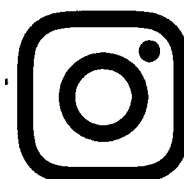
Answer: Join us on Social Media. We post announcements and photos of school events. It's a great way to keep up with KES!

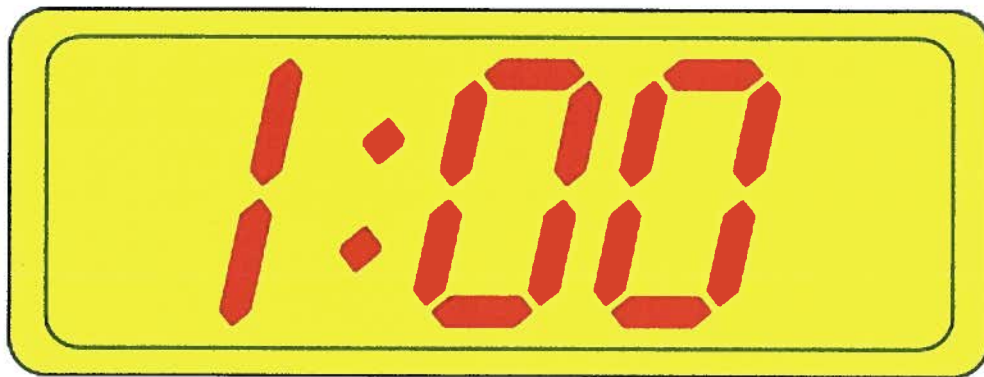

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Information on Head Lice

•Common Issue: 6-12 million people get head lice every year

Prevention

- ⊗ •Avoid head-to-head contact
- ⊗ •Do not share combs, brushes, hats, helmets, towels, hair accessories, etc.
- ✓ •Wash pillows, bedding, towels, clothes, hats, stuffed animals, etc.
- ✓ •Check hair periodically for lice

Treatment


- ✓ •Treat hair immediately
- ✓ •Use over the counter Head Lice Treatment
- ✓ •Remove Nits

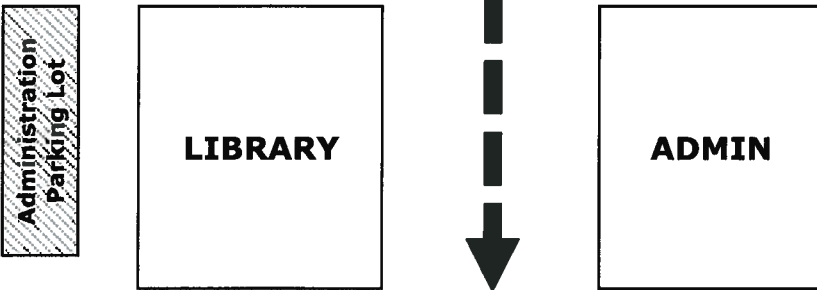

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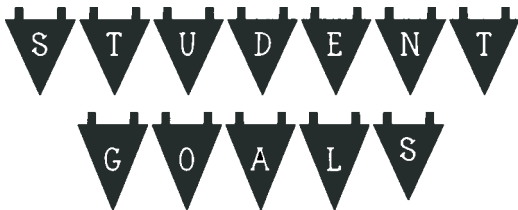
Attendance

Students will turn **OFF** and keep personal mobile devices in their backpacks while on the school campus.



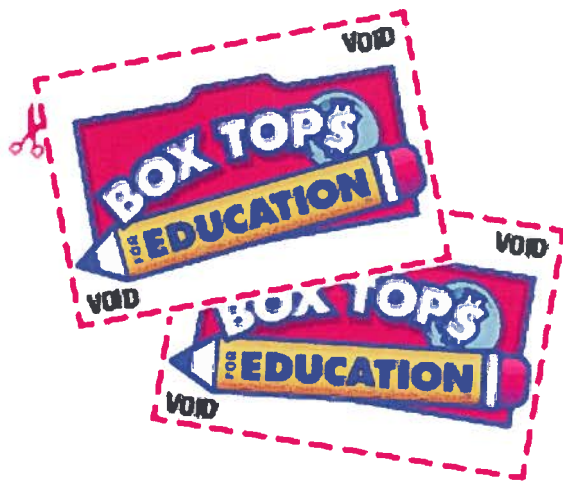
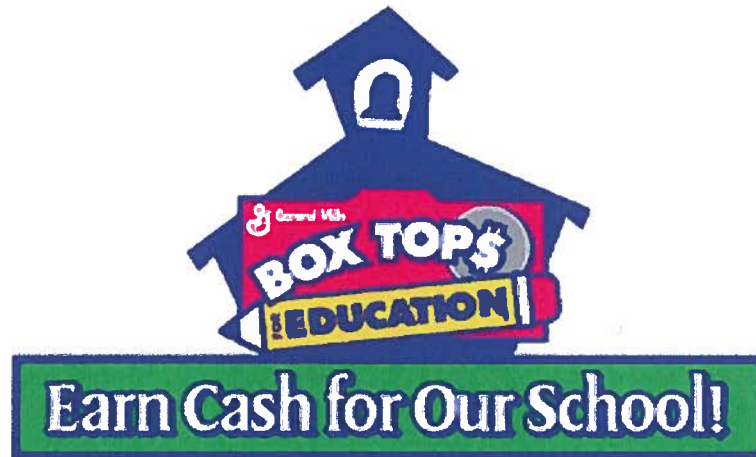
