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Principal's Report:

1. Staffing Update: need to hire a 3rd and 4th grade teacher; new posting for a Special Ed teacher.
2. Re-Opening to happen in the fall with T-shirts, exterior paint, family and staff barbecue. Fourth graders are currently submitting T-shirt design ideas.
3. GT: We have a GT Facilitator, Kristin Cramer, who will also work as a writing interventionist. GT programming includes Social Emotional Learning supports; push-in support, Advanced Learning Plans; GT Committee includes teachers and interventionists with the facilitator.

Achievement Data: Review of DIBELS scores for K-3 in reading, showing growth; decrease in students in the red zone.
