1. Electronics-Engineering Soldering Workshop (Facilitated by SCC

Instructors)

Location: SCC (Main Campus in Dobson) (Room E104)

Dates: June 10 - 11 for ages 11-14

June 12-13 for ages 15-18

Time: 9:00 am-12:00 pm

Class Size: Maximum of 10 for each age group

Class Cost: \$30

Description: During this two-day workshop, the basics of soldering for electronics will be introduced, including soldering safety. A soldering project will be assembled.

2. Agricultural STEM Camp - **CANCELED**

(Facilitated by the Surry Cooperative Ext. Service)

Location: Elkin High School (Students will travel daily to local farms.)

Dates: June 12-14

Time: 9:00 am - 3:00 pm

Class Cost: \$0

Ages: 12-14

Description: Each day campers will load the bus and travel to local farms between Dobson, East Bend and Boonville where they will have a hands-on opportunity to learn more about the agriculture industry as a big business, such as at Hunter Farms. They will receive a special guided tour at Wayne Farms and get an in-depth look at the poultry plant and its production, as well as the Matthews Family Farm to learn about Ag Technologies. From beekeeping to livestock, from chicken to flour milling, to harvesting vegetables and making salsa, this camp is sure to keep everyone busy and engaged! Lunches will be provided two days. Students will need to bring lunch two days. Snacks and drinks will be provided.

Descriptions below for each day:

Day One- “When Seconds Count”

- Cost: \$17.00 (cost of CPR card per student)
- Description:
 - CPR
 - First Aid
- In this Heartsaver CPR and First Aid Course, students will learn how to perform adult, child, and infant CPR with the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). They will also learn how to relieve choking in adults, children, and infants. Students will learn first aid basics for the most common first aid emergencies, including how to recognize them, how to call for help, and how to perform lifesaving skills.

Day Two- “Back to the Basics”

- Cost: \$5.00 (food and supplies to make sewing craft)
- Description:
 - Cooking- Healthy Muffins and Fruit Smoothies
 - Sewing
 - Laundry
- This hands-on class will teach students basic cooking techniques as they prepare and cook healthy muffins and fruit smoothies with a reward of eating their creations. Students will also learn basic sewing techniques as they create their own cupcake pin cushion holder. And finally, knowing how to correctly wash and dry laundry is a necessity of life. This class will make learning these skills “loads” of fun!
