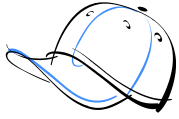


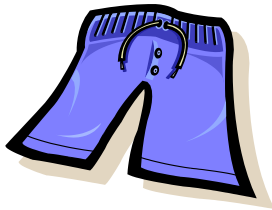
SFISD Dress Code Quick Glance



Hats: Hats, caps, or head coverings of any type will NOT be allowed in the school during the regular school day. Hats in the building will be confiscated.



Shirts: Shirts must be clean, well fitting, and free of holes. All shirts must have a hemmed sleeve. Sleeveless shirts, spaghetti straps and tank tops will NOT be allowed. Graphics promoting drugs, alcohol, or lewd comments will not be allowed. Shirts must cover the mid-drift when arms are raised at shoulder height. Undergarments must not be visible.



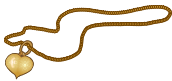
Pants: Pants must be clean, well fitting. They may have holes below mid-thigh as long as they are not excessive in exposure. Shorts and skirts must be finger length. Shorts must not be cut offs. Pants must be worn at the hips and cover the underwear. Sagging will not be allowed. Pajama bottoms will not be allowed.



Shoes: Shoes must be worn at all times. Slippers will not be allowed



Hair: Hair should in no way obstruct vision. Disruptive hairstyles or colors will not be permitted. Hair color must be a natural color. Facial hair is permitted but should be well groomed.



Jewelry: Students may wear ear rings. Boys may wear one stud in each ear. Girls may wear a small stud in the nose. All other visible body and facial piercing or spacers are not allowed. Wallet chains are not allowed. Tattoos must be covered.



Eyewear: Sunglasses are not to be worn during the school day. Contact lenses with designs or colors that distort the natural look of the eyes are not allowed.

Students are expected to follow the dress code during school and at all school activities. Students not in compliance with dress code will be placed in In School Suspension (ISS) until they comply with the dress code. The Principal is in charge of making final decisions concerning dress code compliance.
