Riverview Community School District is thrilled to be using an online program called eSpark to support student learning in both Math & Reading in Gr. K-3. eSpark creates personalized learning plans for our students using highly interactive and academically rigorous apps and videos to engage them and help them grow.

Students at our school have used eSpark for the past few years during a designated time during the school day, and now this year, they will also be able to use eSpark on their personal devices at home for extra practice at a level that's right for them.

When your child does use eSpark at home, please note a couple of things:

- eSpark is designed to help your child learn at his/her unique level. Your child will take quizzes to demonstrate progress, and eSpark uses those quiz results to adjust your child's level to best support his/her learning. For this reason, please do not help your child with these eSpark quizzes. It's important that the quiz results demonstrate what he/she has learned independently.
- Students may use eSpark on any device -- iPads, tablets, Chromebooks, and laptops. If students are using eSpark on a personal iPad at home, please download eSpark from the app store (it's free!). If students are using a non-iPad device, they will go to their internet browser, then go to the website *espark.app* to log in.
- While we'd love students to use eSpark at home for extra practice, it is not required.
