Harvey Elementary Dress Code

Shirts	<p>Maroon polo style shirt or Harvey Spirit shirt (must say "Harvey")</p> <p>Fridays are Brahmas Spirit days and students are encouraged to wear a Brahma polo or t-shirt.</p>
Pants	Khaki long pants (No baggies, overalls). Belt recommended.
Shorts/Capris	<p>Khaki walking (knee length) shorts (No baggies, overalls)</p> <p>Knee length skorts with or without leggings or tights</p> <p>Capris may be worn but must fall below the knee</p>
Skirts/Jumpers	<p>Girls may wear knee length skirts or jumpers.</p> <p>Polo style burgundy uniform dresses (Parents are encouraged to send children with shorts under skirts and jumpers.)</p>
Coats/Jackets	Must follow dress code as set by the school district dress code.
Shoes	For the safety of your child, please send your child to school in closed toe shoes or tennis shoes. Additionally, no shoes/boots with steel toes, noisemaking devices, high-heeled shoes, rollers, slippers, shower shoes (flip-flops) are allowed.
Other	<p>No acrylic nails, tattoos, sunglasses, hats, caps or bandanas of any kind</p> <p>No earrings on boys</p> <p>For student safety during sporting activities, any girls wearing earrings must wear studs or small hoops.</p> <p>No exotic haircuts including but not limited to Mohawks, faux hawks, shaved heads/partially shaved head, sections with long hair strands (tails), shaved designs, partial or full hair color other than natural hair color</p>
Guidelines and Funding	Students must be in compliance one week after school starts. A week is also provided to those students who enter late in the year. Funding Sources: Migrant Funding (Migrant Students) or donated clothing items from the previous year
Principal Authority	<u>Principal shall be accorded the authority/discretion to rule on whether any article of clothing, etc. is acceptable for uniform wear. This shall include items not expressly covered in the handbook.</u>
