

2019 SUMMER SCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION COURSES

CREDIT RECOVERY/ESY

Special education courses will be offered through credit recovery. Students must be recommended for the summer school course through the IEP process, and their counselor. All levels of special education classes will be offered. Courses will be a combination of computer-based instruction, and teacher-directed skill-based instruction to counter possible regression. Courses will follow the general education summer school dates and times. The program will be held at Richards High School from June 10th–July 18th, Monday through Thursday, 7:30am – 1pm. **The week of July 4th will run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 7/1, 7/2, 7/3, and 7/5.*

BUILD/MID ESY

The BUILD/MID ESY summer school program will be held at Shepard High School from June 10th – July 18th, Monday through Thursday, 8am – 12:30pm. Students who need reading or math instruction over the summer months due to potential regression qualify for the ESY summer program. **The week of July 4th will run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 7/1, 7/2, 7/3, and 7/5.*

SUMMIT

The Summit program will be held at the Summit Learning Center from June 3th – June 27th, Monday through Thursday, 8:30am – 12:30pm.

ATP

The ATP summer school program will be held at the Administration Building from June 10th – July 18th, Monday through Thursday, 8am – 12:30pm. Students who need functional reading, math or vocational instruction over the summer months due to potential regression qualify for the ESY summer program. **The week of July 4th will run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 7/1, 7/2, 7/3, and 7/5.*

Autism/Multi-Needs

The Autism/Multi-Needs ESY summer school program will be held at Shepard High School from June 10th – July 18th, Monday through Thursday, 8am – 12:30pm. Students who need reading, math or daily living instruction over the summer months due to potential regression qualify for the ESY summer program. **The week of July 4th will run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 7/1, 7/2, 7/3, and 7/5.*
