**6<sup>th</sup> Grade Enrollment Information** for the 2020-2021 School Year

Enrollment into either of the two middle schools in CVUSD is *not* determined by attendance boundaries. Current 5<sup>th</sup> grade students who reside within the district boundaries may apply to a preferred Middle School February 29 - March 13, 2020. Important enrollment dates are listed below for students entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

**6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent Information Night** Parents/guardians are welcome to attend either or both middle school presentations below:

**February 12, 2020 at 7:00pm** – Canyon (self guided tour begins at 6:30pm)

**February 13, 2020 at 7:00pm** – Creekside (self guided tour begins at 6:30pm)

**February 28, 2020 Deadline for 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Sibling enrollment Application** 5<sup>th</sup> grade siblings of current 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade middle school students are guaranteed enrollment at their sibling's school for the 2020-2021 school year if a 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Sibling Enrollment Application is received **on or before 3:30pm on Friday, February 28, 2020**. A Statement of Residency Form and all of the required residency documentation must be submitted with the form.

**February 29– March 13, 2020 non-Sibling Enrollment of Current 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students** Submit the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Enrollment Application, along with a Statement of Residency Form and all of the required residency documentation to the middle school of your choice **by 3:30pm on Friday, March 13, 2020**.

*If either middle school exceeds their enrollment cap, placement will be determined by lottery. If needed, the lottery will take place on Monday, March 16, at 4:30pm in the CVUSD Board Room.*
