Public Comments: Keith Pavlansky and Kathy Pavlansky spoke to the Board regarding transgender students and the use of restrooms in our schools. They asked that the Board pass a resolution to go against the Governor on this issue.

Several parents of PreK students spoke to the Board regarding the closing of the Forbush Elementary PreK classroom, as well as not enrolling parent-pay students into the program. They all stated that this change would cause a hardship to their children as they were planning to attend the full-time preschool program in Yadkin County. They stated they have looked for other preschool programs in Yadkin County and there are none that are available that are full time. They also stated that they made too much money to qualify for the PreK money that was available and did not make enough money for full time programs such as Forsyth Country Day has. The group stated they would like to plead with the Board to come up with options so that parent-pay students could attend PreK in Yadkin County. They also stated that it is time to turn up the heat with our legislatures because the cuts they have made in the PreK program really hurts small counties. They stated they wished there was a better way to

allocate who receives the slots as it seems those who don't have financial needs are discriminated against. Dr. Martin stated the Board would discuss any options they may have.
