

Cross Curricular Enrichment Specialist

Orientation to Teaching and Learning:

The Curriculum Enrichment Specialist must come from an orientation that all children are gifted and a commitment to provide experiences that provide opportunities for students to discover and develop their gifts.

Essential Duties:

1. Collaborate with grade level colleagues on Thematic Units that meet grade level state standards
 - a. Demonstrate knowledge of content and pedagogy
 - b. Set appropriate instructional goals
 - c. Design coherent lesson plans
 - d. Design formative and summative assessments that measures student performance based on established learning targets.
 - e. Demonstrate a basic understanding of current technology that is incorporated as a natural instructional tool.
2. Design 4-6 week thematic units based on core subject areas, which includes hands on extension activities for deeper understanding of content area
3. Develops rubrics to assess student understanding for grading purposes
4. Differentiates instruction for students to be successful in content areas
5. Incorporates a variety of differentiated subject integration which includes (Art, SS, Sci, Technology, ELA, Math, Native American Studies)
