The purpose of the meeting is to discuss developments and take action, as necessary, dealing with: the coronavirus, Gov. Cooper's Executive Orders 116 (declaring a state of emergency), 117 (prohibiting mass gatherings and mandating public school closures), and 120 (extending public school closures through May 15, 2020 and prohibiting mass gatherings of more than 50 people), the State Board of Education's Resolutions adopted March 14 and 23, 2020, and to conduct a closed session to receive legal advice from the Board's Attorney.
