Dear Parents,

The timely completion of the registration process is critical to our effective planning for the 2018-2019 school year. The registration process allows us to accurately plan the number of sections needed for each course, hire the appropriate number of qualified teachers for these courses, order and acquire adequate instructional materials, build a school master schedule and individually schedule students in a manner that accommodates as many of their needs and requests as possible. Each of these things must be done accurately and in sequence in order for us to have an organized start of the school year in August. Because of the intricacies of planning for the coming school year, I ask for your cooperation in completing the registration process accurately and in a timely manner.

We are asking that **EVERY** student **update their immunization records** on file. ALL students need to **submit a copy of current immunizations with their registration packet.**

As has always been the case, we never want a student to leave SPHS solely because of the financial need of the family. If your family's current financial circumstances make it impossible for you to pay the full registration fee by the scheduled due date, but you still want your son/daughter to continue at SPHS, please get in touch with Mrs. Pat Duda as soon as possible to explore possible financial arrangements. Standard practice in the Department of Catholic Schools is to increase tuition between 4% - 7% each year.

Tuition and Fee Schedule

2018-2019 School Year

Tuition

- ◆ Swordsman Parent Rate \$ 7,645
 - This option requires 25 mandatory parent service hours, \$250 participation in the Annual Raffle and one other mandatory fundraiser, and fulfilling the Science and Technology Family Pledge.

Registration Fee

This fee covers the cost of scheduling, counseling services, tutoring, testing (PSAT and ACT), PowerSchool, student emergency supplies, report cards, and mailings. Student courses will be assigned based on early and regular registration. Late registration does not guarantee student preference for courses.

Early Registration (March – April)	\$350
Regular Registration (May)	\$450
Late Registration (June or after)	\$550

Student Activities Fee (due before October 1) \$425

This fee is separate from the registration fee. It includes the student body fee/activity card, yearbook, class ring (given in the junior year), class/laboratory fees, retreat fees, locker, parking permits, and college visits.

Fundraising / Annual Raffle (due before class schedules can be picked up) \$250 / \$140

The Annual Raffle takes place at the Back to School night in September. The raffle tickets must be paid for before student schedules are picked up. There will be another **mandatory** fundraiser in the spring.

iPad Rental (due by Sept. 15) \$150

Freshman will be issued a school iPad for use throughout the school year.

Science and Technology Family Pledge

Parents are asked to make an annual pledge to cover the gap between total education cost (\$11,780) and what is charged for tuition (\$7,535). This amounts to \$4,245 per student each year. In addition, parents can help support the continuation of construction of the new science center and technology throughout the campus. Parents can pledge all or part of the gap; the recommended minimum pledge is \$300 a year per family. Donations are tax-deductible.

Pep Squad (parents should plan on spending about \$1,000)

Multiple Student Discount	
2 nd sibling in family enrolled (25% discount given)	\$1,885 off tuition
3 rd sibling in family enrolled (50% discount given)	\$3,765 off tuition
Tuition Payment in full by July 15, 2016 (3% discount)	\$7,300
Tuition paid in two equal installments (July 15 & Jan. 15)(1.5% discount)	\$3,710 x 2 (\$7,420 total)
