

## Eisenhower Prom 2019 Prom General Information

- When:** Friday, May 17, 2019 from 6:30 – 11:00pm. Check-in begins at 6:25 pm, seating begins 6:30, and dinner will be served buffet style at 6:45pm. No one will be admitted after 7:30pm. You (and your guest) **MUST** have a picture ID to enter. No exceptions.
- Seating:** Reserved seating will be available at the time of ticket purchase, have all names of students that will be sitting at your table when you purchase your ticket.
- What:** Prom is a school function. All Eisenhower High School and CHSD 218 rules apply at prom and will be enforced. Eisenhower students take full responsibility to inform and insure a guest's compliance to these rules. Noncompliance may result in guests being asked to leave prom.
- Where:** Mid-America Club, AON Building, 200 East Randolph Dr., Chicago, IL 60601 80<sup>th</sup> Floor
- Dress Code:** Formal attire is required. Dress code will apply and will be enforced. If you have any attire related questions; please see Ms. Russell or Ms. Delejewski in the attendance office. Dresses cannot be (1) shorter than your fingertips; (2) cut below the bust line; (3) with a back cut below the natural waist; (4) show stomach areas. You will be asked to change or be sent home if you are in violation of the dress code. Tuxedos or a suit is required.  
*There will be NO REFUND if you violate dress code*
- Pictures:** Life Touch will be the photographer. Photography information will be distributed with the purchased tickets. Payment is required at the time of photo.
- Menu:** Dinner will be served buffet style.
- Guests:**
- The maximum age for your prom date is High School Age to 20 years old at time of prom
  - If your guest is not a student at Eisenhower High School, **a guest form must be turned in at the time you purchase tickets**. The guest form can be found in your registration packet.
  - No guest forms will be accepted or will be approved after 4/21
  - If your guest attends another school they must have the guest form signed by a dean at their school.

- Regular ticket sales: April 17, 2019 – April 18, 2019 - \$110.00 per person
  - Late ticket sales: April 24, 2019 & April 25, 2019 - \$120.00 per person

  - Cash or check (made payable to Eisenhower High School) (*no credit card payments*)
  - No tickets sold to any student with school fines

# Eisenhower Prom 2019 Prom Dress Code

## **Why does DDE have a Prom dress code?**

Prom is a **CLASSY, ELEGANT** night. To be a part of an elegant night, we *require elegant, appropriate attire.*

## **FAQ:**

1) Can I wear a strapless dress?

*YES! As long as it meets all other dress code requirements*

2) What happens if I arrive at prom and I do **NOT** meet dress code?

*You will be going home and you will **NOT** get a refund.*

2) My date does not go to school here; what if her/his attire does not meet dress code?

*Your date be going home and you will **NOT** get a refund.*

## **Dress Code**

#1 Dresses may not be cut below the bust line

#2 The back of the dress may not be cut below the belly button

#3 Dresses may not have ANY part of the stomach area exposed

#4 Dresses may not be shorter (or have a slit) shorter than where your fingertips naturally fall

#5 No cover-ups (shawls/wraps, sweaters, tuxedo coats) will be allowed to cover up dresses that do not meet the dress code. The dress must meet dress code without the shawl or jacket

#6 Undergarments must not be visible

#7 Formal Tuxedos or Dress Suit (Coat & Tie) for Gentlemen. No Hats of any kind are allowed
