The Mary Alice Lucey O'Malley Scholarship Program at Saint Joseph Hill Academy

Established by Mary Alice Lucey O'Malley, '60

Mary Alice O'Malley graduated from St. Joseph Hill Academy in 1960. She went on to St. Vincent's Hospital in Manhattan, where she graduated as a registered nurse in 1963. The Mary Alice Lucey O'Malley scholarship is open to the daughters of Registered Nurses and First Responders. Each scholarship will provide approximately 80% of the total annual tuition for each student for their four (4) years of enrollment at St. Joseph Hill Academy. Each awardee family will be required to pay only 20% of the tuition and fees per school year. Parents and/or lawful guardians of incoming Freshmen who are eligible to apply should fill out the attached application.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS:

Daughters of Nurses: Approximately 80% tuition scholarships are available for eligible incoming Freshmen.
Daughters of First Responders: Approximately 80% tuition scholarships are available for eligible incoming Freshmen.

Total Scholarships Available: Three (3) new scholarships providing approximately 80% of annual tuition are available for each of the next 10 years.

SCHOLARSHIP DURATION & ONGOING QUALIFICATION:

Each awarded Mary Alice Lucey O'Malley scholarship will be provided to awardees for approximately 80% of annual tuition for all four (4) of their enrollment years at St. Joseph Hill Academy High School. Grades and conditions will be reviewed each year before continuing awards are granted.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES & PRIORITIES:

- Applicants must submit two (2) letters of reference.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum 85 final average in each award year with no failures and remain in good disciplinary standing to maintain program eligibility.
