LISA Academy is a tuition-free public charter school with a comprehensive college preparatory program focusing on Science, Mathematics, English and Technology.

In 2018-19 school year LISA Academy had three campuses: LISA Academy West in Little Rock, which has served 7th through 12th grades since 2004, LISA Academy North in Sherwood, which has served kindergarten through 12th grade since 2008, and LISA Academy Chenal in Little Rock, which has served kindergarten through 6th grade since 2016.

LISA Academy had around 2,200 students enrolled and over 5,000 students on the waiting list.

All LISA Academy schools have been accredited by the Department of Education since they opened.

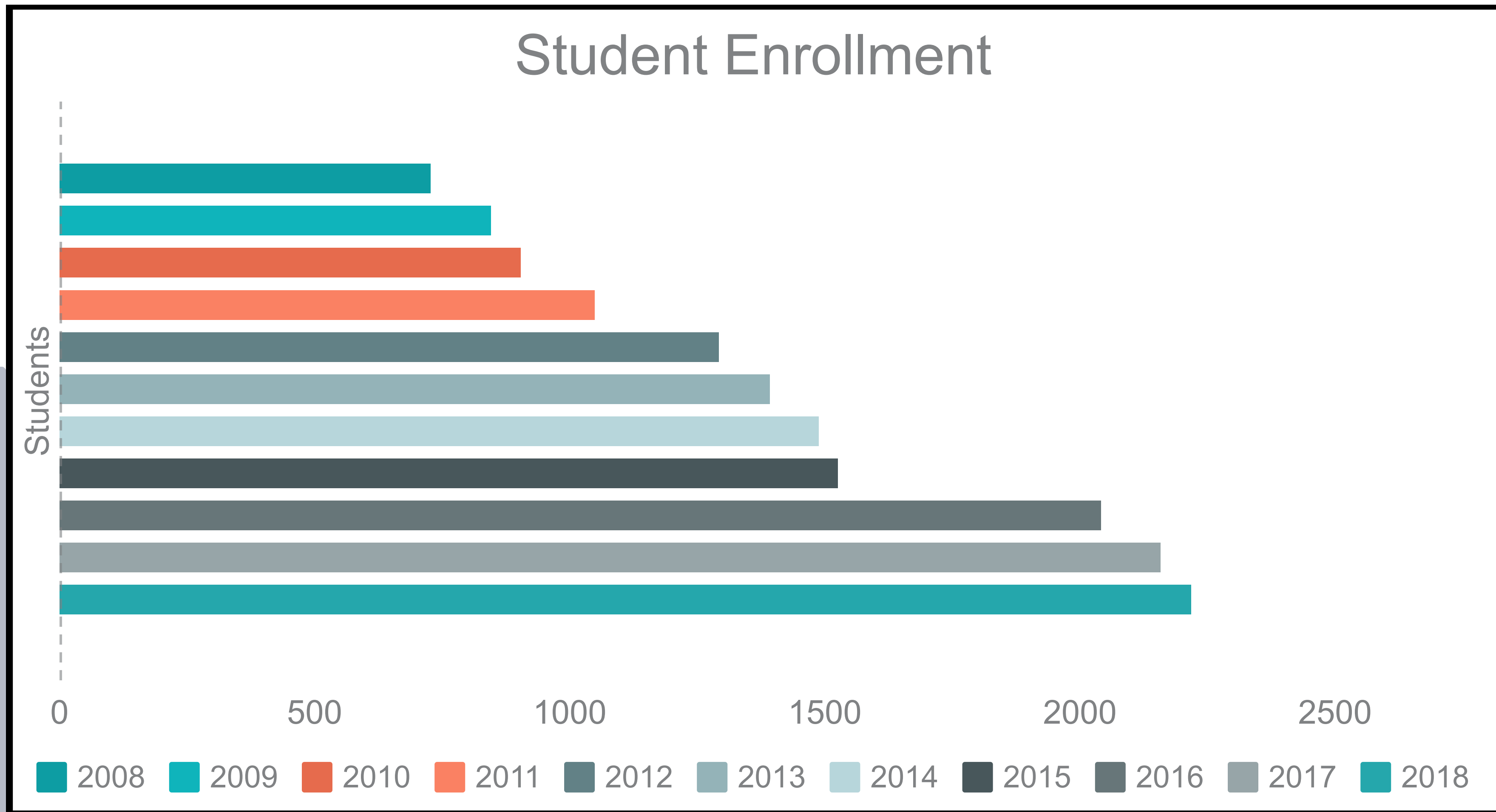

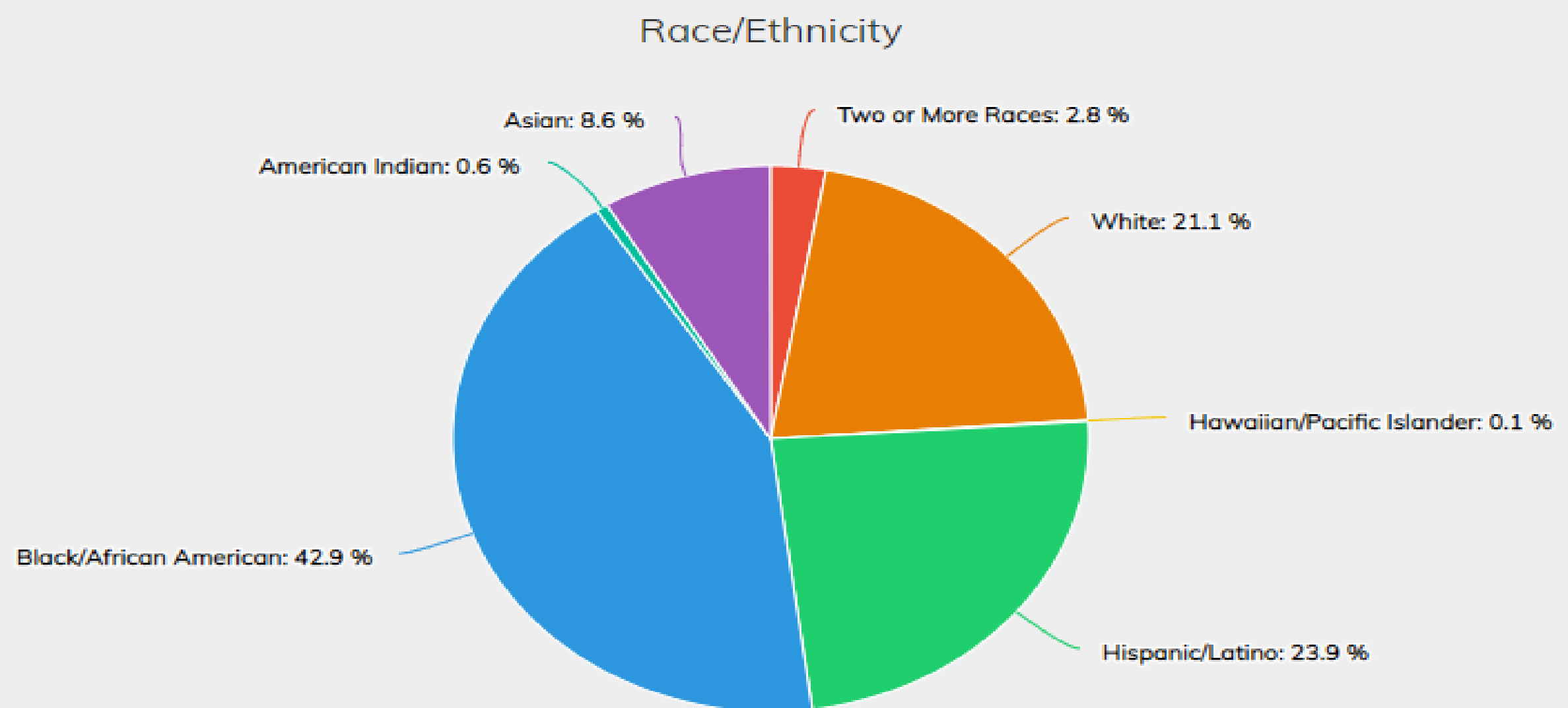

This year, there are 31 languages represented across our four LISA campuses.



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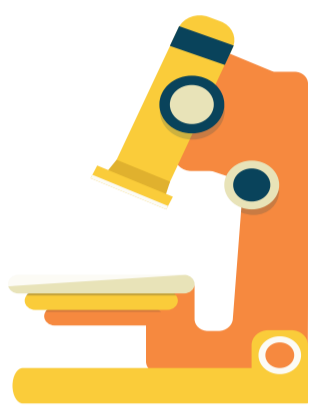

Continue to prepare students to be active, informed citizens with leadership skills and social, cultural, and global awareness.



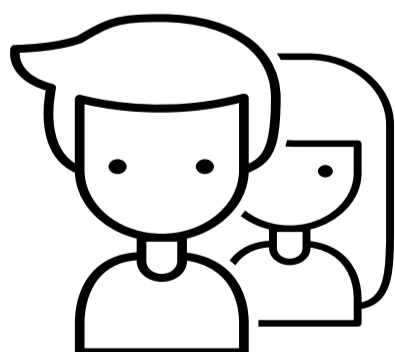
Continue to help students develop and improve computer skills.
