



Utah State Board of Education's Student Advisory Council ("SAC")

The SAC will meet to discuss how decisions made at the state level are affecting students throughout Utah. Members are advisors and act as liaisons between the Utah State Board of Education (USBE) and the students of Utah. The meetings will include discussions to provide student suggestions, reactions, insights, and opinions concerning the State Board's policies, initiatives, and efforts regarding relevant educational issues. They will also include exploring issues relevant to students on a statewide level that may require Board consideration or action.

SAC members will be expected to attend all meetings and to comply with all the duties and responsibilities outlined in the Utah State Board of Education's Student Advisory Council Policy (See Attached). These duties include fulfilling the full two-year term for incoming 11th grade members and one-year term for incoming 12th grade members.

For the 2018-19 school year, SAC meetings will take place every other month beginning November 2018 and concluding with a final meeting in May 2019. SAC meeting schedules will be determined by the SAC at the first meeting held November 9, 2018 at 2:30 PM at the Utah State Board of Education Office, 250 East 500 South, Salt Lake City Utah 84114. All travel to meetings are subject to general State Board reimbursement and per diem policies (see attached) and meetings will be made available electronically for those unable to travel to the meeting location.

All 11th and 12th grade students who are at least 16 years old by Sept. 1st are eligible to apply. **To be considered for the council, applications must be received by Friday, October 5, 2018. Only applications received by this date or earlier will be accepted.**
