TRANSPORTATION ROUTES AND SERVICES

Transportation shall be as listed below for each school:

A. Bordentown Regional High School Transportation Grades 9-12

All students will be eligible for transportation except those living:

1. Within the Southgate/Rydal Apartment complex;
2. In all areas between Ward Avenue and Crosswicks Road from Route 130/206 to Charles Bossert Drive and Willow Road.

B. Bordentown Regional Middle School Transportation Grades 6-8

All students will be eligible for transportation.

C. MacFarland Intermediate School Transportation Grades 3-5

1. All students residing within the City limits on Park Street from Seminary Drive to Route 206 will be eligible for transportation;
2. All students residing on Lucas and Landon Drive, due to hazardous walking conditions, will be eligible for transportation;
3. All others will be walkers.

D. Clara Barton School Transportation Grades K-2

1. All students residing on Park Street from Seminary Drive to Route 206 will be eligible for transportation;
2. All students residing on the south side of Bordentown Chesterfield Road (Crosswicks Road) inclusive of all of Holloway Lane and the Holloway Meadows housing development will be eligible for transportation;
3. All students residing on Lucas and Landon Drive, due to hazardous walking conditions, will be eligible for transportation;
4. All others will be walkers.

E. Peter Muschal School Transportation Grades K-5

1. All students living within the township will be eligible for transportation except those living:
  - a. Within the Southgate/Rydal Apartment complex;
  - b. in all areas between Ward Avenue and Crosswicks Road from Route 130/206 to Charles Bossert Drive and Willow Road.

2. Pre-K Students

All students will be eligible for transportation.

F. Fieldsboro Resident Transportation

Students living in Fieldsboro are eligible for busing to all schools to which they are assigned.

G. Special Education Transportation

Special Education students who require transportation services shall be based in accordance with their Individualized Education Program (IEP).

H. Babysitter Transportation

Since the legal purpose of this transportation is to provide for the passage of students to and from their legal domicile, the board, therefore, shall not provide for transportation of students to or from residences other than their homes, neither on a day-to-day basis nor any longer period of time except in the following situation:

1. Transportation shall be provide for the passage of students to and from a babysitter provided the parent or legal guardian of the child and the babysitter, complete the board-approved authorization form which authorizes the district to pick up and discharge the student at or near the premises of the student's babysitter;
2. In the case of a babysitter who is a minor, the parent/guardian of the babysitter shall complete and sign the authorization form;
3. The babysitter or the parent/guardian of a babysitter who is a minor accepts full responsibility for the safety of the student prior to boarding and after departing the bus.
